

LOCAL LAW NO. 1-2018

LOCAL LAW TO RESCIND THE CURRENT PROCUREMENT POLICY AND ADOPT THE
PROCUREMENT POLICY AS DETERMINED BY THE AGENCY CREATED AS PER
STATE FINANCE LAW §161(2)(d)

Be it enacted by the Board of the Village of Boonville as follows:

Section 1. Title

This Local Law shall be referred to as “Local Law No. 1-2018” or “Local Law to Rescind the Current Procurement Policy and Adopt the Procurement Policy as Determined by the Agency Created as Per State Finance Law §161(2)(d)”.

Section 2. Purpose and Intent.

It is the intent of this Local Law to rescind or repeal the current procurement policy, and instead adopt the procurement policy as determined by the agency created as per State Finance Law §161(2)(d).

Section 3. Separability.

The provisions of this Local Law are separable and if any provision, clause, sentence, subsection, word or part thereof is held illegal, invalid, unconstitutional or inapplicable to any person or circumstance, such illegality, invalidity or unconstitutionality, or inapplicability shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, clauses, sentences, subsections, words or parts of this Local Law or their application to other persons or circumstances. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that this Local Law would have been adopted if such illegal, invalid or unconstitutional provisions, clause, sentence, subsection, word or part had not been

included therein, and as if such person or circumstance, to which the Local Law or part thereof is held inapplicable, had been specifically exempt therefrom.

Section 4. Repealer

All Ordinances, Local Laws and parts thereof inconsistent with this Local Law are hereby repealed. Specifically, the current procurement policy.

Section 5. Effective Date.

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the New York State Secretary of State in accordance with Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
