## TOWNSHIP OF ANTRIM, FRANKLIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

ORDINANCE NO. 329

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING THE "PER CAPITA TAX" ARTICLE OF CHAPTER 130 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ANTRIM, PENNSYLVANIA

WHEREAS, the Local Enabling Act (P.L. 1257, No. 511), which was enacted December 31, 1965, in part authorizes Second Class Townships to impose a tax for general revenue purposes known as the "Per Capita Tax"; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Antrim currently imposes a Per Capita Tax in accordance with the Local Tax Enabling Act No. 511; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Antrim desires to repeal the Per Capita Tax.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Supervisors of the Township of Antrim, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION I. Article III known as the "Per Capita Tax" contained in Sections 25 through 29 of Chapter 130 of the Code of Township of Antrim is hereby repealed. The remaining Articles and Sections of Chapter 130 shall be renumbered accordingly.

SECTION II. REPEALER. Except as set forth hereafter, all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances and any Sections of the Code of the Township of Antrim inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

<u>SECTION III.</u> <u>EFFECTIVE DATE</u>: The repeal of the Per Capita Tax shall be effective as of January 1, 2013 and all calendar years thereafter unless repealed or modified by future Ordinance of the Township of Antrim. In addition, nothing herein shall be construed to repeal the imposition of other taxes, plus applicable penalties and interest. In all other respects, Chapter 130 of the Code of the Township of Antrim shall remain in effect.
