## Local Law 2 of 2024

A Local Law Amending Chapter 174 "Streets and Sidewalks" of the Code of the Village of Ballston Spa

Be it enacted by the board of trustees of the village of Ballston Spa that

Section Two of Chapter 174 shall be amended as follows:

§ 174-2. Reimbursement for sidewalks.

Whenever sidewalks are constructed, repaired, and/or replaced on the streets of said Village with the consent of the DPW Superintendent of approved material and of the width provided by law, the owner of the premises adjoining such walk who shall have constructed, repaired, and/or replaced the same will be paid, with approval of the Board of Trustees, a reimbursement amount as set by resolution of the Board from time to time. Receipts and bills of items of the cost thereof must accompany all claims for such payment, along with proof that said construction, repair, and/or replacement is in compliance with currently-existing Department of Transportation and Americans with Disabilities Act legal requirements.

Subsection B of Section Twenty of Chapter 174 shall be amended as follows:

174-20 Curbing specifications; reimbursement

B. The owner of the premises adjoining such curb who shall have constructed, repaired, and/or replaced the same will be paid, with approval of the Board of Trustees a reimbursement amount as set by resolution of the Board from time to time. Receipts and bills of items of the cost thereof must accompany all claims for such payment along with proof that said construction, repair, and/or replacement is in compliance with currently-existing Department of Transportation and Americans with Disabilities Act legal requirements.
