

**LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF 2021**  
**LOCAL LAW AMENDING CHAPTER 75-9, ARTICLE IV, ENTITLED "BUILDING AND ZONING DEPARTMENT FEES"**

**BE IT ENACTED**, by the Town Board of the Town of Beekman of the County of Dutchess as follows:

**SECTION 1:** Chapter 75-9(A) of the Town Code of the Town of Beekman is hereby amended by updating the Building Code and Zoning Code Fee Schedule by the following addition:

**Building Permit/Site Plan Review Fee for Agricultural uses: Non-resident buildings used in the furtherance of "farm operations" as defined in Section 301 of the Agriculture and Markets Law: \$0.20 sq. ft.**

**SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY**

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section or part of this Local Law or the application thereof to any person, individual, corporation, firm, partnership, entity or circumstance shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair, effect or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section or part of this law or in its application to the person, individual, corporation, firm, partnership, entity or circumstance directly involved in the controversy in which such order or judgment shall be rendered.

**Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE**

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
