

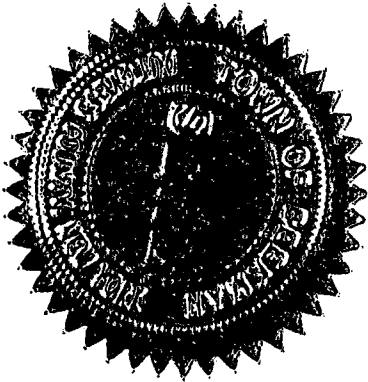

**A LOCAL LAW PROVIDING FOR THE REDUCTION OF THE SALARY OF  
THE TOWN RECEIVER OF TAXES**

Local Law # 4 of 2017.

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Beekman, in the County of Dutchess, as follows:

**SECTION 1. PURPOSE AND INTENT**

This local law provides for the reduction of the salary of the elected town office of Town Receiver of Taxes of the Town of Beekman, New York in order to reduce the burden of the provision of municipal services on the taxpayers of the Town of Beekman, New York.

**SECTION 2. AUTHORITY**

The Town Board of the Town of Beekman enacts this Local Law under the authority granted by:

1. Article IX of the New York State Constitution, §2
2. New York Statute of Local Governments, § 10(1)
3. New York Municipal Home Rule Law, § 10(1)(i) and (ii), §10(1)(a)(1), and §10(1)(a)(3).
4. Town Law §27(1).

**SECTION 3. DEFINITIONS**

In this local law: "Town" shall mean the Town of Beekman, New York.

"Town Receiver of Taxes" shall mean the elected Town receiver of taxes and assessments of the Town of Beekman, New York, as embodied in Article 3 of the Town Law.

**SECTION 4. SALARY REDUCTION**

Currently, the individual elected to be the Town Receiver of Taxes of the Town of Beekman, New York, is paid an annual salary of Thirty-Seven Thousand Five Hundred Eighty-Three Dollars (\$37,583.00). Commencing with the term of office immediately following the effective date of this local law, and for all terms thereafter unless changed by subsequent local law, the individual elected to be the Town Receiver of Taxes of the Town of Beekman, New York, shall receive an annual salary of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00).

#### **SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY**

If any section of this local law shall be held unconstitutional, invalid, or ineffective, in whole or in part, such determination shall not be deemed to affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this local law.

#### **SECTION 6. REFERENDUM NOT REQUIRED**

As the salary change will begin with the commencement of a new term of office, and does not impact the salary of a currently-elected office during the term of office, this local law is not subject to mandatory referendum.

#### **SECTION 7. FILING**

In accordance with §27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law, within twenty days after a local law shall finally have been adopted, the clerk, or other officer designated by the legislative body, is directed to file one certified copy thereof in the office of such clerk, one copy with the office of the county clerk and one certified copy in the office of the secretary of state.

#### **SECTION 8. EFFECTIVE DATE**

This local law shall take effect on filing with the Secretary of State.
