**Ordinance No. 19-01**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BELLEVUE, A HOME RULE CHARTER MUNICIPALITY, REGULATING DESIGNATED LOADING ZONE LOCATIONS AND TIMES OF USE.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF BELLEVUE HEREBY ORDAINS:**

**Section 1:** The locations described are hereby designated as Loading Zones. No person shall park a vehicle in said location during the times indicated other than for the loading or unloading of goods and materials for a time limit of 20 minutes.

**Section 2: Locations:**

- 1) Lincoln Avenue in front of 575 Lincoln Avenue.
- 2) N. Sprague Avenue at Lincoln Avenue. (First marked parking space on the Eastern side of N. Sprague Avenue.)
- 3) S. Balph Avenue at Lincoln Avenue (First marked parking space on the Western side of S. Balph Avenue.)
- 4) Lincoln Avenue in front of 409 Lincoln Avenue.
- 5) Hawley Avenue at Lincoln Avenue (First marked parking space on the Eastern side of Hawley Avenue.)

**Section 3: Enforcement time periods;** loading zones will be enforced by the Bellevue Borough Police Department from 6:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m.

**Section 4: Penalty;** any person violating any provision of this ordinance is guilty of a summary offense and shall, upon conviction be sentenced to pay a fine of \$25.00.

**Section 5:** that any ordinance, or part thereof, conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance is hereby repealed insofar as the same effects this ordinance.
