8	SECTION 1. Chanter 28 of the Town of Cumberland Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to
9 10	SECTION 1: Chapter 38 of the Town of Cumberland Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to add the following Article to establish a resident-only parking permit program:
11	ARTICLE VII RESIDENT-ONLY PARKING PERMIT PROGRAM
12 13 14	§ 38-100. Resident-Only Parking Permit Program. There is hereby created a resident only permit parking program to benefit densely populated streets with limited parking for residents of such streets or neighborhoods as applicable (the "Program").
15 16	§ 38-101. The Town Council may permit resident-only parking by ordinance and on the recommendation of the Cumberland Police Department.
17 18 19 20	§ 38-102. The creation of resident-only parking areas shall be based on neighborhood conditions, including density of the street or neighborhood, the relative lack of driveways, amount of off-street parking available, frequency of overnight parking, and other related conditions that support restricting parking to residents.
21 22	§ 38-103. Conditions of resident-only parking areas may include, but not be limited to, hours of resident-only parking.
23 24	§ 38-104. The Public Works Department shall provide appropriate signage as directed by the Police Department.
25 26 27	§ 38-105. A proposal for this program shall be reviewed by the Traffic Management Group and shall be reviewed substantially in conformance with the Traffic Calming Policy's procedural requirements.
28 29 30	§ 38-106. Upon establishing a resident-only parking area, the Police Department shall be responsible for implementing and administering the program with appropriate procedures, policies, forms and identifying tags or stickers.
31 32 33	§ 38-107. Any person residing within a designated resident-only parking area is eligible to participate in the Program, provided that they meet the requirements for the specific area, which may include the following:

34	(a) The vehicle must be registered to the address or verified to be assigned to the resider
35	if the registered owner is the resident's employer or other evidence that a vehicle has
36	a legitimate parking purpose in the area; and
37	(b) The resident applying for a permit under the Program must provide proof of
38	residency; and
39	(c) All outstanding parking violations issued on the vehicle registration must be paid; an
40	(d) The number of vehicles per residential dwelling unit that may be eligible to receive a
41	permit unless special circumstances are presented and approved by the Police
42	Department; and
43	(e) Commercial vehicles are not eligible to obtain a permit under this Program unless an
44	exception is made at the discretion of the Police Department, e.g. for small business
45	owners that use a small commercial vehicle for business and personal use.
46 47 48	§ 38-108. Guest Parking. Guest parking may be permitted at the request of a permit holder uponotice to the Police Department. Excessive requests may not be approved by the Police Department. § 38-109. Any person who parks without exhibiting a permit on a street or area obtained under
50	this Program shall be subject to the penalties and fines provided in § 38-7 of this Chapter.
51	§ 38-110. The following defined areas are subject to this section:

53	SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage.
