ORDINANCE NO. 164 OF 2016

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 19, PART 1, SECTION 113
(§19-113 (1)E(1)) OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
CUMBERLAND, REGARDING POLITICAL SIGNS WITHIN THE
TOWNSHIP OF CUMBERLAND

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Cumberland, Adams County, Pennsylvania deems it to be in the best interest and the general welfare of the citizens and residents of the Township to update and amend Chapter 19, Part 1, Section 113 (1)(E)(1) of the Code of the Township of Cumberland, entitled "Political Signs."

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the Supervisors of Cumberland Township, Adams County, Pennsylvania, that Chapter 13, Part 2, of the Code of the Township of Cumberland, is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 1. The existing Chapter 19, Part 1, Section 113 (1) (E) (1) of the Code of the Township of Cumberland entitled "*Political Signs*" is hereby amended by removing subsection (d) and replacing subsection (c) with the following:

(c) All political signs shall be removed within two days after election day.

SECTION 2. Repealer. All provisions of previous Ordinances of the Township of Cumberland which are contrary to this Ordinance are expressly repealed.

SECTION 3. Savings Clause. In all other respects, the Code of the Township of Cumberland shall remain as previously enacted and ordained.

SECTION 4. Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable, and if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or part thereof is, for any reason, held to be invalid to be unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of any remaining sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or part of this ordinance.

SECTION 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with law.
