

ORDINANCE NO. 815-2020

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST PENNSBORO, AT CHAPTER 1, ADMINISTRATION OF GOVERNMENT, PART 3, APPOINTED OFFICIALS, TO ESTABLISH THE APPOINTED POSITION OF TOWNSHIP TREASURER AND ESTABLISH DUTIES, COMPENSATION, AND BOND REQUIREMENTS FOR TOWNSHIP TREASURER.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Township of East Pennsboro, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania desires to amend its Code of Ordinances as it pertains to administration of government per the appointment of certain officials, to include the appointment of Township Treasurer in accordance with Section 801-A, et seq, of the First Class Township Code;

IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of East Pennsboro Township, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1: CHAPTER ONE [Administration of Government], Part Three [Appointed Officials] is amended to provide at Section 3C as follows

C. Treasurer

§320. Appointment.

The Board of Township Commissioners shall appoint by duly passed Resolution a Treasurer for East Pennsboro Township, which individual shall also be that employee of the Township holding the position of Finance Administrator. The person so appointed shall serve as Treasurer at the pleasure of the Board of Commissioners.

§ 321. Duties.

The Township Treasurer shall have those duties and responsibilities as contained in Section 803-A of the First Class Township Code (54 Pa.C.S.A. §55803-A), or any amended or successor provision or law, ordinance or resolution, together with those duties and responsibilities associated with such individual's regular employment as an employee of East Pennsboro Township.

§ 322. Compensation.

Compensation of the Township Treasurer shall be determined by the Board of Commissioners.

§ 323. Bond.

The Township Treasurer shall be bondable and give a fidelity bond to the Commonwealth in an amount at least equal to 50% of the amount of funds of the Township as established by the Board of Commissioners to be available to the Treasurer at any time during the current year. The cost of such fidelity bond shall be paid by the Township.

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: In all other respects, Chapter One [Administration of Government] of the Code of Ordinances of the Township of East Pennsboro shall remain as heretofore enacted, ordained and amended, which said Chapter, as amended, is hereby re-enacted in its entirety herein.

SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall become effective upon enactment.


