ORDINANCE NO.845-2023

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST PENNSBORO, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING ITS CODE OF ORDINANCES AT CHAPTER 15, [THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC ORDINANCE] BY AMENDING §15-402 [PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES] FOR CERTAIN AREAS ALONG THE NORTH SIDE OF COLLEGE HILL ROAD WEST OF THE INTERSECTION WITH B STREET IN THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST PENNSBORO, AND REPEALING INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of East Pennsboro, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1: Section 15-402 [Parking Prohibited at All Times in Certain Locations], Chapter 15 [Motor Vehicles and Traffic] of the Code of Ordinances of the Township of East Pennsboro is hereby amended, in alphabetical order, to provide for the following no parking at all times at the following locations:

Street	<u>Side</u>	Between
College Hill Road	North	100 feet West of Intersection of B Street
College Hill Road	North	beginning at a point 200 feet West of Intersection of B Street a distance of 350 feet
College Hill Road	North	beginning at point 450 feet West of intersection of B Street a distance of 630 feet
College Hill Road	North	beginning at a point 700 feet West of intersection of B Street a distance of 868 feet

SECTION 2: In all other respects, Chapter 15 [Motor Vehicles and Traffic] of the Code of Ordinances of the Township of East Pennsboro shall remain as heretofore enacted, ordained and amended, which said Chapter, as amended, is hereby re-enacted in its entirety herein.

SECTION 3: REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: SEVERABILITY. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable. If any of its provisions shall be held to be unconstitutional, illegal, or otherwise invalid, that decision shall not affect the remaining provision of the Ordinance or any other Ordinances of the Township.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment.
