ORDINANCE NO. 1009

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF EMSWORTH, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, REVISING THE BOROUGH'S SANITARY SEWER RATE STRUCTURE TO INCREASE THE ADDITIONAL FEE FOR WATER USAGE IN THE BOROUGH.

NOW, be it ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Emsworth, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by Authority of the aforesaid as follows:

Section 1. Amendments.

Chapter 186, Article VI ("Sanitary Sewer Rates"), which currently states:

Section 186-27. Minimum Usage Fee

Subsection B(2) which currently states:

2. Each customer shall also pay a flat quarterly usage fee of Two Dollars (\$2.00), plus an additional Five Dollars and 35/100 Cents (\$5.35) for each one thousand (1,000) gallons of water used for charges assessed by the Borough.

Shall be amended to state as follows:

2. Each customer shall also pay a flat quarterly usage fee of Two Dollars (\$2.00), plus an additional Five Dollars and 60/100 Cents (\$5.60) for each one thousand (1,000) gallons of water used for charges assessed by the Borough.

Section 2. Effective Date.

These amended fees shall be imposed upon all customers pursuant to the Motion of Council at its regularly advertised meeting on December 9, 2020, effective the first billing cycle of January, 2021.
