



**AN ORDINANCE**

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Fitchburg, as follows:

Article 2 § 169-58 entitled Violations and Penalties be amended as follows (**bold and underline** is new language and ~~cross through~~ is omitted language):

B. Pursuant to the provisions of MGL c. 90, § 20A 1/2, any person violating any provision of any rule, regulation, order or ordinance regulating the parking of motor vehicles shall be punished by a fine for each offense as hereinafter set forth:

(1) Group A, \$300.

- (a) 01. Handicapped parking.
- (b) 02. Blocking a wheelchair ramp.
