

**RESOLUTION ADOPTING A LOCAL LAW AMENDING CHAPTER 460-74  
SCHEDULE XXV OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF GREENBURGH AS  
IT PERTAINS TO FLAT RATE METERS IN OFF-STREET PARKING  
AREAS OF THE HARTSDALE PUBLIC PARKING DISTRICT**

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board of the Town of Greenburgh finds that the Code of the Town of Greenburgh needs to be amended to reflect the change made to flat rate parking meters in the Hartsdale Public Parking District because the Hartsdale Public Parking District Commissioners, who have sole jurisdiction over such matters, have already adopted and implemented the change; and

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 460-74 Schedule XXV of the Code of the Town of Greenburgh, Meters in Off-Street Parking Areas, due to the Hartsdale Public Parking District Commissioners changing the meter rates for flat rate parking meters, currently has incorrect data which must be corrected; and

**WHEREAS**, on February 8, 2023, the Town Board of the Town of Greenburgh held a public hearing on this matter as required when the Code is amended;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, the Town Board of the Town of Greenburgh hereby adopts the attached Local Law amending Chapter 460-74 Schedule XXV of the Code of the Town of Greenburgh as it pertains to flat rate parking meters in off-street parking areas of the Hartsdale Public Parking District (HPPD).

**§ 4. Severability**

If any provision of this local law is found by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, such findings shall not be deemed to invalidate the local law as a whole, nor any other section or provision thereof, other than that which is found to be unconstitutional or otherwise invalid.

**§ 5. Effective Date**

This local law shall take effect on January 1, 2023.
