RESOLUTION ADOPTING A LOCAL LAW AMENDING CHAPTER 460-74 SCHEDULE XXV OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF GREENBURGH AS IT PERTAINS TO FLAT RATE METERS IN OFF-STREET PARKING AREAS OF THE HARTSDALE PUBLIC PARKING DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Greenburgh finds that the Code of the Town of Greenburgh needs to be amended to reflect the change made to flat rate parking meters in the Hartsdale Public Parking District because the Hartsdale Public Parking District Commissioners, who have sole jurisdiction over such matters, have already adopted and implemented the change; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 460-74 Schedule XXV of the Code of the Town of Greenburgh, Meters in Off-Street Parking Areas, due to the Hartsdale Public Parking District Commissioners changing the meter rates for flat rate parking meters, currently has incorrect data which must be corrected; and

WHEREAS, on February 8, 2023, the Town Board of the Town of Greenburgh held a public hearing on this matter as required when the Code is amended;

- § 1. Title. This law is entitled "A local law amending Chapter 460 of the Town Code as it pertains to flat rate parking meters"
- § 2. Legislative Findings and Intent.

The Town Board of the Town of Greenburgh hereby finds that the Code of the Town of Greenburgh be amended to reflect the new flat rate parking meter rates adopted by the Hartsdale Public Parking District.
