A local law amending Chapter 157 with respect to removal of vehicles, fines, towing and storage fees

as follows:

Pursuant to the Authority conferred in Section 7-700 of the Village Law of the State of New York, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Green Island hereby repeals Section 157-26 C and D in their entirety adopts a new Section 157-26 C and D and adds a new Section 157-27. I.

Section 1.

C. Parking rules during snow emergencies.

- (1) The Village has the power to ticket vehicles which are not moved during snow removal when requested, and the owner or person entitled to possession of such vehicles shall be held liable for a fine of \$125.00 per offense.
- (2) During snow emergencies, all streets within the Village are to be considered snow emergency routes.

D. Whenever any vehicle is ticketed by a peace officer or law enforcement officer for the violation of any section of this Chapter 157, it shall be subject to removal from the location where ticketed. The owner or person entitled to possession of said vehicle shall be held liable for the removal and towing charges of \$125.00 per offense, or actual towing costs incurred, whichever is greater.

After removal of any vehicle as provided in this article, the Village may store or cause such vehicle to be stored in a suitable place at the expense of the owner. Such owner or person in charge of the vehicle may redeem the same upon payment to the person with whom the vehicle was stored the amount of all expenses actually and necessarily incurred in effecting such removal and storage, such storage charge to be \$10.00 per day or any part thereof when stored on Village property or the actual charges incurred when stored on any privately owned facility.
