Such owner or person in charge of the vehicle may redeem the same upon payment to the person with whom the vehicle was stored the amount of all expenses actually and necessarily incurred in effecting such removal and storage, such storage charge to be \$10.00 per day or any part thereof when stored on Village property or the actual charges incurred when stored on any privately owned facility.
