

Pursuant to the Authority conferred in Section 7 - 700 of the Village Law of the State of New York, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Green Island hereby adopts and enacts Local Law No. 1 of 2021 as follows:

Section 1. Subsection 157-40. Schedule VIII: Stop Intersections.

Section 157-40. Schedule VIII: Stop Intersections is hereby amended to add as follows:

This local law shall take effect upon filing with the Secretary of State of the State of New York.


