AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF HADDONFIELD, IN THE COUNTY OF CAMDEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY CHAPTER 232 "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC" ARTICLE IV "PARKING", SECTION 232-25 "PARKING TIME LIMITED ON CERTAIN STREETS" AND SECTION 232-32 "METERED PARKING", SUBSECTION D OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF HADDONFIELD

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Borough of Haddonfield (hereinafter "Borough") deems it appropriate, necessary, and proper to amend Chapter 232 "Vehicles and Traffic" of the Borough Code;

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of Commissioners of the Borough of Haddonfield in the County of Camden, State of New Jersey as follows:

#### SECTION I

Chapter 232, "Vehicles and Traffic" Section 232-25 "Parking time limited on certain streets", of the Code of the Borough of Haddonfield, is hereby amended and will read as follows:

No person shall park a vehicle for longer than the time limited between the hours listed on any day (except Sundays and public holidays) upon any of the streets or parts of streets described, unless so described elsewhere in this Code: (new items are underscored)

### SECTION II

Chapter 232, "Vehicles and Traffic" Section 232-32 "Metered Parking", Subsection D, of the Code of the Borough of Haddonfield, is hereby amended and will read as follows:

- D. The metered parking shall be of the following categories, as to parking time permitted and the costs required to secure said parking time:
  - (1) Street parking: \$0.50 for each one-hour period up to three hours plus any applicable minimums and/or convenience fees as required.
  - (2) Parking lots: \$0.50 for each one-hour period plus any applicable minimums and/or convenience fees as required.
  - (3) Street parking and Parking Lot metered parking shall be free of charge for the first 10 minutes but must still be recorded through the current Borough approved parking mobile device application.
  - (4) In accordance with <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40:48-2.12t the Borough of Haddonfield created a Senior Citizen Priority Parking Program through Resolution 2023-136 on August 28, 2023 to allow Borough of Haddonfield residents,

who are age 60 or older, to obtain a parking permit annually to park his or her own vehicle at any metered parking spaces as opposed to requiring payment each time through the Borough of Haddonfield's current meter system.

#### **SECTION V**

If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of the Ordinance shall be declared invalid for any reason whatsoever, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance which shall continue in full force and effect, as to this end the provisions of the Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

### SECTION VI

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by law.
