**ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 291 VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, ARTICLE IV –  
TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, CHAPTER 291-28 STOP INTERSECTIONS  
TO ADD STOP SIGN ON PURCE STREET AT THE INTERSECTION OF  
PURCE STREET AND ARNOLD STREET**

**ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 291 VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, ARTICLE IV –  
TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, CHAPTER 291-28 STOP INTERSECTIONS  
TO ADD STOP SIGN ON PURCE STREET AT THE INTERSECTION OF  
PURCE STREET AND ARNOLD STREET**

**WHEREAS**, a traffic control study has been undertaken regarding the flow of traffic at the intersection of Purce and Arnold Streets and it has been determined that a “STOP” sign on Purce Street at the intersection of Arnold and Purce Streets would assist in regulating the flow of traffic.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HILLSIDE THAT:**

1. Chapter 291 Vehicles and Traffic, Article IV Traffic Regulations Section 291-28. Stop Intersections shall be amended as follows:

<b>Intersection</b>	<b>Stop Sign On</b>
<i>Purce Street and Arnold Street</i>	<i>Purce Street</i>

2. SEVERABILITY

If any provision of this Ordinance, or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstances, shall be held invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance to the extent it can be given effect, or the application of such provision to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby, and to this extent the provisions of this Ordinance are severable.

3. REPEALER

All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent with any provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to the extent of such inconsistencies.

4. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall become effective twenty (20) days following the final adoption thereof by the Township Council of the Township of Hillside and shall be published as required by law.




