

Parking Regulations

IT IS HEREBY ENACTED that the following sections of the Code be amended as follows:

**Section 239-32 Schedule VIII (Parking Prohibited at All Times)** In accordance with the provisions of § 239-12, no person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any of the following described streets or parts of streets.

*Add/Modify:*

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Location</u>
Columbia Parkway	Both	From Philip Street to Buchannan Street
Columbia Parkway	Median	Entire Length
South Fifth Ave.	Median	Entire Length
Second Street	South	From South Fifth Ave. to Barringer Road
First Street	North	From Otsego Street continuing 80 feet west; From 181 feet east of Morgan Street continuing 20 feet east

**Section 239-35 Schedule XI (Parking Prohibited Certain Hours)** In accordance with the provisions § 239-15, no person shall park a vehicle between the hours listed upon any of the following described streets or parts of streets.

*Add:*

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Time Limit; Hours/Day</u>	<u>Location</u>
Weber Ave.	Both	7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. school days	Entire Length
Lester Ave.	South	All day Nov. 1 through April 30	30 feet east and west of the View Terrace curbline including the abutting right-of-way owned by the Village

Section 239-41 Schedule XVII (Handicapped Parking) in accordance with the provisions of § 239-20.3, the following locations are designed as handicapped parking areas.:

<u>Name of Street/Lot</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Hours/Day</u>	<u>Location</u>
First Street	North	All	From 109 feet east of Morgan Street to 129 feet east of Morgan Street

This law shall take effect immediately upon its filing with the Secretary of State.

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
