**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A
REDEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE CAPITAL PROGRAM APPLICATION
AND BUSINESS PLAN TO THE COMMONWEALTH OF
PENNSYLVANIA GOVERNOR’S OFFICE OF THE BUDGET.**

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Capital Facilities Debt Enabling Act authorizes funding for eligible economic development capital projects through the Redevelopment Assistance Capital Program (RACP); and

WHEREAS, Governor Wolf signed Act No. 52 on October 30, 2017, which authorizes reimbursement funding for “acquisition, rehabilitation, infrastructure and construction for a regional public safety facility in Western Lycoming County”; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Jersey Shore, in Western Lycoming County, is seeking funding for a regional public safety facility; and

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Governor’s Office of the Budget requires the submittal of an Application and Business Plan to qualify for RACP funds;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Penn Strategies, LLC is authorized to file the required RACP Application and Business Plan on behalf of the Borough of Jersey Shore in an amount not to exceed \$1,000,000 (One Million Dollars) to be used for the construction of the municipal Highway Department Operations Building and two related outbuildings with the project name “Tiadaghton Valley Regional Police Public Safety Building,” RACP ME 300-2119-00.
