AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF KILBUCK, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING CHAPTER 200, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, OF THE KILBUCK TOWNSHIP CODE OF ORDINANCES TO ADD A NEW SECTION 200-7, PROHIBITING THE PARKING OF BOATS, RECREATIONAL VEHICLES, RECREATIONAL TRAILERS AND UTILITY TRAILERS ON TOWNSHIP STREETS, AUTHORIZING THE TOWING OF ILLEGALLY PARKED BOATS, RECREATIONAL VEHICLES, RECREATIONAL TRAILERS AND UTILITY TRAILERS AND IMPOSING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors takes legislative notice that parking of certain large trucks, trailers, boats, motor homes, etc. on certain Township streets creates safety hazards to vehicles, limits the ability of emergency response vehicles to freely and safely move along such streets, diminishes visibility for motorists and pedestrians, reduces available parking for passenger cars and is unsightly.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED and ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Kilbuck, Allegheny County, as follows:

I. Chapter 200, Vehicles and Traffic, of the Kilbuck Township Code of Ordinances is amended by adding a new Section 200-7, Parking of Boats, Recreational Vehicles and Trailers, to read in its entirety as follows:

§ 200-7. Parking of Boats, Recreational Vehicles and Trailers.

A. Definitions. As used in this Section 200-7:

1. "Boat." A vessel for travel on water.
2. "Boat Trailer." A trailer designed to haul a boat or watercraft.
3. "Recreational Vehicle." A vehicle with an enclosed area which is designed, constructed or equipped for use, either permanently or temporarily, as a dwelling place, living abode, sleeping place or camping accommodation.
4. "Recreational Trailer." A trailer which is designed, constructed or equipped as a dwelling place, living abode or sleeping place, either permanently or temporarily.

5. "Trailer." A vehicle designed to be towed by a motor vehicle.
 6. "Utility Trailer." An open or enclosed trailer which is used for the hauling of goods.
 7. "Vehicle." Every device in, upon or by which any person or property is or may be transported or drawn upon a highway, except devices used exclusively upon rails or tracks. The term does not include a self-propelled wheelchair or an electrical mobility device operated by and designed for the exclusive use of a person with a mobility-related disability.
 8. "Watercraft." A craft for travel on water or a watercraft.
- B. Prohibition. At all times, it shall be unlawful for any person to park, or to allow to remain parked, any boat, boat trailer, watercraft, recreational vehicle, recreational trailer, or utility trailer on any Township or public street.
- C. Violation and Tow Away Zones.
1. The streets designated in Subparagraph B above shall be posted as locations in which the parking of boats, boat trailers, watercraft, recreational vehicles, recreational trailers, and utility trailers are prohibited.
 2. Where a street is posted as set forth above and a boat, boat trailer, watercraft, recreational vehicle, recreational trailer, or utility trailer is parked on such street in violation of this Ordinance, the Township or an agent of the Township may remove such boat, boat trailer, watercraft, recreational vehicle, recreational trailer or utility trailer and place it in storage. In order to reclaim the boat, boat trailer, watercraft, recreational vehicle, recreational trailer or utility trailer, the owner shall pay 100% of all towing and storage costs incurred by the Township plus a removal fee of \$50.00. After due notice to the owner, the boat, boat trailer, watercraft, recreational vehicle, recreational trailer or utility trailer may be sold or otherwise disposed of by the Township.
- D. Penalties. Any person who violates any terms of this Section 200-7, shall be subject to a penalty of up to Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for each such violation, together with all costs of disposing of the boat, boat trailer, watercraft, recreational vehicle, recreational trailer or utility trailer. Each day of continued parking in violation hereof shall constitute a separate offense.

II. Chapter 200, Vehicles and Traffic, of the Kilbuck Township Code of Ordinances is further amended by renumbering existing Section 200-7, Violations and Penalties, to Section 200-8.

III. Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance, shall be severable and, should any of the provisions hereof be held invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

IV. Repealer. All ordinances or resolutions which conflict with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

V. Effective Date. The provisions of this ordinance as enacted by this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon recordation in the Ordinance book.


