Local Law No. 2 of the year 2024

A local law to amend Chapter 230, Section 230-1, of the Code of the Village of Lancaster to accommodate the recodification of the Town of Lancaster Anti-Noise Ordinance.

Whereas when enacted Village Code Ch. 230 §230-1 incorporated by reference the “Anti-Noise Ordinance” of the Town of Lancaster, Ch. 38 of the Town Code, together with all subsequent modifications, amendments and recodifications, and

Whereas the Town of Lancaster Anti-Noise Ordinance has been recodified from Chapter 38 to Chapter 221, now;

To accommodate the Town recodification of its Anti-Noise Ordinance;

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Lancaster as follows:

1) Village Code Ch. 230, § 230-1 shall be amended to read as follows:

§ 230-1. Adoption of standards.

Sections 221-2 through and including 221-7 of the Anti-Noise Ordinance of the Town of Lancaster, New York, found at Ch. 221 of the Town Code together with all subsequent modifications, amendments and recodifications thereto, shall be deemed incorporated within the Code of the Village of Lancaster as if fully stated herein.

2) This local law shall become effective the 20th day following its enactment.
