ORDINANCE NO. 682

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MANHEIM, LANCASTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ARTICLE IV, ENTITLED "GENERAL PARKING REGULATIONS", OF CHAPTER 205, ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC", BY AMENDING: (1) SECTION 205-35, ENTITLED "PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES IN CERTAIN LOCATIONS", BY ADDING THERETO NO PARKING ON THE (a) EAST SIDE OF SOUTH PITT STREET BETWEEN WEST FERDINAND STREET AND WEST HIGH STREET, (b) EAST SIDE OF NORTH PITT STREET BETWEEN WEST HIGH STREET AND WEST CHESTNUT STREET, AND (c) WEST SIDE OF NORTH PITT STREET FROM WEST CHESTNUT STREET SOUTHWARD 75 FEET; (2) SECTION 205-37, ENTITLED "PARKING OF TRUCKS AND CERTAIN VEHICLES PROHIBITED IN BOROUGH; EXCEPTIONS", BY AMENDING SUBSECTION C.(4) TO PROHIBIT PARKING OF CLASS 3 COMMERCIAL REGISTERED VEHICLES 10,001 POUNDS OR GREATER FOR A PERIOD OF TIME IN EXCESS OF 12 HOURS; AND (3) SUBSECTION B OF SECTION 205-39, ENTITLED "SPECIAL PURPOSE PARKING ZONES ESTABLISHED; PARKING OTHERWISE PROHIBITED", BY ADDING THERETO A HANDICAP PARKING SPACE AT 126 SOUTH GRANT STREET.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Manheim, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the authority of the same as follows:

Section 1. Section 205-35 entitled "Parking prohibited at all times in certain locations", of Article IV, entitled "General Parking Regulations, of Chapter 205, entitled "Vehicles and Traffic", of the Manheim Borough Code of Ordinances is hereby amended and restated in its entirety so as to hereafter read as follows:

§ 205-35. Parking prohibited at all times in certain locations.

Parking shall be prohibited at all times (except that vehicles may be parked there during loading and unloading) in the following locations:

<u>Section 2</u>. Subsection C.(4) of Section 205-37 entitled "Parking of trucks and certain other vehicles in Borough; exceptions", of Article IV, entitled "General Parking Regulations", of Chapter 205, entitled "Vehicles and Traffic", of the Manheim Borough Code of Ordinances is hereby amended and restated in its entirety so as to hereafter read as follows:

(4) Commercial registered vehicles registered as a Class 3, 10,001 pounds or greater.

Section 3. Subsection B., entitled "Handicap parking spaces are established at the following locations in the Borough on the dates noted in parentheses:", of Section 205-39 entitled "Special purpose parking zones established; parking otherwise prohibited", of Article IV, entitled "General Parking Regulations", of Chapter 205, entitled "Vehicles and Traffic", of the Manheim Borough Code of Ordinances is hereby supplemented by adding thereto the following:

126 South Grant Street (3/9/2021)

Section 4. The provisions of this Ordinance are severable, and if any section, sentence, clause, part or provision hereof shall be held to be illegal, invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision of the court shall not affect the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, parts or provisions of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Borough that such Ordinance would have been enacted if such illegal, invalid or unconstitutional section, sentence, clause, part or provision had not been included herein.

Section 5. The Manheim Borough Code of Ordinances, as amended, shall be and remain unchanged and in full force and effect except as amended, supplemented and/or modified by this Ordinance. This Ordinance shall become a part of the Manheim Borough Code of Ordinances, as amended, upon adoption.

Section 6. All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Borough which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall become effective at the earliest date permitted by law following the date of its enactment.
