

ORDINANCE NO. 1-2018

ORDINANCE NO. 2-2018 AMENDS THE MINERAL TOWN CODE, TO ADD PRIVATE SWIMMING POOLS AS A USE IN ALL ZONING DISTRICTS WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT AND TO PRESCRIBE THE MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS RELATED TO SWIMMING POOLS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mineral Town Council, that the Code of the Town of Mineral shall be amended to add to Article IX, "Special Provisions" Section 425-57.1 "Swimming Pools" to read in its entirety as follows:

**"Section 425-57.1 Swimming Pools**

A. Fees

The fee for a zoning permit for a residential swimming pool shall be fifty dollars (\$50.00).

B. Swimming Pools Permitted

After receipt of any and all required permits, swimming pools are permitted in all zoning districts with the exception of the general commercial district.


C. Swimming Pool Requirements

The edge of the swimming pool must be at least ten feet (10') from any alley, the property line and any overhead utility lines.

All requirements from the Virginia Department of Health must be followed.

Any swimming pool that is deeper than two feet (2') shall be fenced in accordance with all of the requirements of the Louisa County Code regarding gates and fencing, which are incorporated by reference."
