

ORDINANCE 04-24
TOWNSHIP COUNCIL - TOWNSHIP OF MINE HILL
MORRIS COUNTY, NEW JERSEY

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 175, "BUILDINGS UNFIT FOR HUMAN HABITATION, OCCUPANCY, OR USE" OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MINE HILL AND ADDRESSING THE APPOINTMENT OF AN ENFORCEMENT OFFICER

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Council of the Township of Mine Hill, in the County of Morris, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 175 of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Mine Hill, "Buildings Unfit for Human Habitation, Occupancy, or Use," Section 175-1, "Enforcement Officer" shall be amended to read, in its entirety, as follows:

§ 175-1. Enforcement officer.

The Housing Officer, Construction Official, Health Officer, or any other person appointed by the Township Administrator is hereby designated as the officer charged with enforcement of this code and is hereinabove referred to as the "Enforcement Officer". They shall serve in such capacity without any additional salary. Each may act individually to exercise the powers established under this Chapter.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance may be renumbered for codification purposes.

SECTION 3. All Ordinances of the Township of Mine Hill which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final adoption and publication.
