AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLE 360-3 (c) of the Code of the Village of Naples (Vehicle and Traffic Law No Parking Zones)

Article 360-3 (c) of the Code of the Village of Naples is hereby amended to include the following subsections:

21. On the south side of Mt. Pleasant Street commencing at the intersection of Main Street (NYS Rte. 21 and the centerline of Mt. Pleasant Street and continuing in a westerly direction to the intersection of the centerlines of Mt. Pleasant Street with the centerline of West Avenue.
22. On the north side of Mt. Pleasant Street commencing at a distance of 350 feet westerly from the intersection of the centerlines of Mt. Pleasant Street and Main Street (NYS Rte. 21) and continuing thence westerly to the intersection of the centerlines of Mt. Pleasant Street and West Avenue.
23. On the west side of Main Street (NYS Rte. 21) commencing at a point in the southern edge of the driveway entrance of 202 N. Main Street and continuing thence southward for a distance of 18 feet.
24. Commencing at a point in the northern street line of Mt. Pleasant Street where it intersects with the west line of Main Street (NYS Rte. 21) and continuing thence in a northerly direction a distance of 20 feet.
25. Commencing at a point in the southern street line of Mt. Pleasant Street where it intersects with the west line of Main Street (NYS Rte. 21) and continuing thence in a southerly direction a distance of 20 feet.
26. Commencing at a point which is 18 feet northerly of the north boundary of the driveway entrance to 192 North Main Street and continuing thence in a southerly direction for a distance of 30 feet beyond the south boundary line of the driveway entrance of 188 N. Main Street.
27. Commencing at a point 18 feet north of the northernmost driveway entrance at 182 N. Main Street and continuing thence in a southerly direction for a distance of 15 feet beyond the southernmost driveway entrance to 182 N. Main Street.
28. On the east side of North Main Street (NYS Rte. 21) at the following locations:
 - a. Commencing at the intersection of the north curb line of NYS Rte. 245 with the east line of Main Street (NYS Rte. 21) and continuing thence north along the east line of Main Street (NYS Rte. 21) a distance of 20 feet.
 - b. Commencing at the intersection of the south curb of NYS Rte. 245 with the east line of Main Street (NYS Rte. 21) and continuing thence south along the east line of Main Street (NYS Rte. 21) a distance of 20 feet.

c. Commencing at a point 20 feet north of the driveway entrance to 199 N. Main Street and continuing thence south along the east line of Main Street (NYS Rte. 21) for a distance of 20 feet south of the north line of the driveway to 197 North Main Street.

Article 360-3 (f) of the Code of the Village of Naples is hereby amended to include the following subsections:

10. Commencing at a point in the east line of Main Street (NYS Rte. 21) which is 20 feet south of the south line of the southernmost driveway to 197 N. Main Street (NYS Rte. 21) and continuing thence in a southerly direction along the east line of Main Street (NYS Rte. 21) a distance of 20 feet to a point.

11. Commencing at a point in the west line of Main Street (NYS Rte. 21) which is 18 feet south of the southernmost edge of the driveway to 202 N. Main Street (NYS Rte. 21) and continuing thence south along the west line of Main Street (NYS Rte. 21) a distance of 18 feet to a point.

12. Commencing at a point in the west line of Main Street (NYS Rte. 21) which is 30 feet south of the south street line of Mt. Pleasant Street and continuing thence in a southerly direction along the west line of Main Street (NYS Rte. 21) a distance of 18 feet to a point.
