Amend Chapter 33, § 33-3, Qualifications, by adding a new subsection (D):

§ 33-3. Qualifications.

Any person serving in the position of Town Prosecutor shall:

D. Be a resident of the Town of New Castle.

Amend Chapter 34, Residency Requirements, by amending § 34-3, Residency requirements established, as follows:

34-3. Residency requirements established.

Any person holding an appointed public office within the Town of New Castle need not be a resident or an elector of the Town of New Castle, provided, however, that such person shall reside within the State of New York or any county adjoining Westchester County, except that all members of local Town boards and commissions shall remain electors of the Town of New Castle and the Town Prosecutor shall be a resident of the Town of New Castle.

This Local Law shall be effective immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.


