

**TOWNSHIP OF PARSIPPANY-TROY HILLS
MORRIS COUNTY, NEW JERSEY
ORDINANCE NO. 2023:08**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PARSIPPANY-TROY HILLS,
MORRIS COUNTY, NEW JERSEY DONATING CERTAIN PROPERTY TO
THE PARSIPPANY VOLUNTEER AMBULANCE SQUAD**

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:12-13, a municipality may sell personal property not needed for public use, which sale may be in the form of a donation to a charitable organization providing emergency medical services to the community; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Parsippany-Troy Hills (the “Township”) owns certain personal property, including a 2013 Ford E350 ambulance bearing Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) 1FDXE4FS4DDA08225 (the “Property”), which is currently in use by the Parsippany Volunteer Ambulance Squad for public safety purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council hereby finds and declares that the Property is no longer needed for public use; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council desires to sell the Property to the Parsippany Volunteer Ambulance Squad, a nonprofit corporation of the State of New Jersey which provides emergency medical services in the Township of Parsippany-Troy Hills, County of Morris, New Jersey, for its own use, which sale shall be for nominal consideration.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Parsippany-Troy Hills, Morris County, New Jersey, as follows, that:

SECTION 1. The Township shall sell certain of its personal property identified as a 2013 Ford E350 ambulance bearing Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) 1FDXE4FS4DDA08225 to the Parsippany Volunteer Ambulance Squad, a nonprofit corporation of the State of New Jersey which provides emergency medical services in the Township of Parsippany-Troy Hills, County of Morris, New Jersey.

SECTION 2. The sale shall be for nominal consideration.

SECTION 3. All actions of the Township taken prior to the date of adoption hereof contemplated by this Ordinance are hereby ratified and approved.

SECTION 4. If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any remaining part thereof.

SECTION 5. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances of the Township of Parsippany-Troy Hills heretofore adopted that are inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
