WHEREAS, on June 28, 2022, via the adoption of Ord. No. 22-047, the Municipal Council created Chapter 172 of the Paterson Code, entitled "Cannabis Licensing and Operating," pursuant to the State authority of N.J.S.A. 24:6I-45; and

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WHEREAS, generally-related matters are governed by Paterson Code Chapter 445, Article III, entitled "Medical Cannabis Transfer Tax," created on October 13, 2020 via the adoption of Ord. No. 20-058, and amended on May 12, 2022 via the adoption of Ord. No. 22-042; and

WHEREAS, other generally-related matters are governed by the amendments to Paterson Code Ch. 113, Art. II, now titled "Consumption in Public of Alcohol or Cannabis," whose said amendments were made on January 18, 2022 via the adoption of Ord. No. 22-002; and

WHEREAS, now, in 2023, the Council wishes to increase the number of licenses for Class 1 Cultivators (i.e., growers) from three (3) to six (6), where more than three (3) licensees have already been given conditional approval by the State of New Jersey, subject to local municipal approval; and

WHEREAS, the Council also wishes to provide for refunds for unsuccessful applicants.
