

**TOWN OF RAYMOND  
SECOND SESSION MINUTES  
MARCH 12, 2019**

The Town of Raymond second session was held Tuesday, March 12, 2019 at the Iber Holmes Gove Middle School Gymnasium. The Accuvote ballot machines were tested on March 1, 2019 starting at 9:30 a.m. by Town Clerk Sharon E. Walls, Town Moderator Kathleen Hoelzel, and School District Clerk Linda Hoelzel. On March 12, 2019 before the polls opened, Assistant Moderator Edward French and Assistant Moderator Timothy Louis inspected and locked the ballot boxes. Zeroed tapes on the Accuvote machines were printed and posted at 6:32 a.m. Moderator Hoelzel declared the polls open at 7:00 a.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Supervisors of the Checklist Kathleen McDonald, Lisa Morrill, and Aimee Hayes were present. Moderator Hoelzel swore in Ballot Clerks Kathleen Stockley, Jennifer Ferrante, Michelle Dubin, and Adam Beck. Thomas Krantz was sworn in as an assistant election official. Selectmen Jack Barnes, Wayne Welch, Greg Bemis, George Plante, and Scott Campbell chose to be election officials. Town Clerk/Tax Collector Sharon Walls and the School District Clerk Linda Hoelzel were present. Moderator Hoelzel announced that Timothy Louis and Edward French were sworn in as Assistant Moderators for this election. Moderator Hoelzel addressed the rules for the election. She addressed the rules for electioneering and stated they were posted outside in the area of electioneering. She went outside and addressed the electioneering rules. The opening of the absentee ballots was posted and commenced at 9:00 a.m. and remained open until 5:00 p.m. The ballot boxes were emptied at 12:04 p.m., 12:30 p.m., 2:10 p.m., and 4:10 p.m. The ballot boxes were re-locked and the ballots were secured during the Election. Moderator Hoelzel declared the polls closed at 7:00 p.m. After the polls closed the write-ins were counted. Assistant Moderator Edward French declared the Article 1-Elected Officials voting results and Moderator Hoelzel declared the remaining election voting results.
