I hereby certify that the following is a true copy of a local law which was duly passed by the Council of the City of Rochester on November 15, 2022 and Approved by the Mayor of the City of Rochester, and was deemed duly adopted on February 6, 2023 in accordance with the applicable provisions of law.

Local Law No. 2024-8

Local Law amending City Charter Section 6-71.9 with respect to exemption from taxes for persons with disabilities and limited incomes

BE IT ENACTED, by the Council of the City of Rochester as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 755 of the Laws of 1907, entitled "An Act Constituting the Charter of the City of Rochester", as amended, is hereby further amended by modifying Section 6-17.9 to read in its entirety as follows:

§ 6-71.9. Tax exemption for persons with disabilities and limit incomes.

The Council hereby approves the partial tax exemption of qualifying real property that is owned by one or more persons with a disability whose income is limited by reason of such disability, as authorized in § 459-c of the Real Property Tax Law, Persons with disabilities and limited incomes, to commence with the 2018-19 tax year. In addition, Council hereby approves providing said tax exemption to qualifying property owners whose income exceeds the maximum income eligibility level set forth in Subsection 459-c(5)(a), provided that the exemption is reduced proportionately in accordance with Subsection 459-c(1)(b). The exemption provided for in this section shall also be applicable to taxes levied for school purposes. Commencing with the 2023-24 tax year assessment roll initiated on the taxable status date of February 1, 2023, the Council hereby approves and authorizes increasing the income limits and adjusting the exemption percentages for the foregoing tax exemption program as follows:
