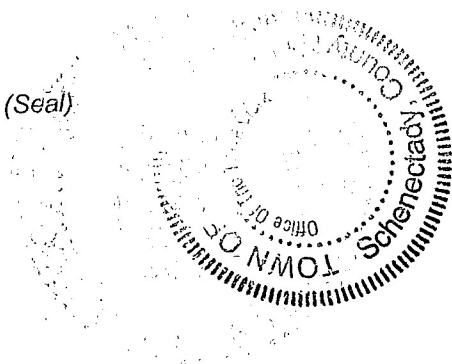

At the regularly scheduled public meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Rotterdam, held at the John F. Kirvin Government Center, 1100 Sunrise Boulevard, Rotterdam, New York 12306 on Wednesday, March 27, 2024, at 7:00 p.m., the following resolution was duly adopted:

RESOLUTION NO. 149.24

TO ENACT INTRODUCTORY LOCAL LAW NO. 4 OF 2024; TO AMEND SECTION 266-42, ENTITLED "SCHEDULE II: ONE-WAY STREETS" OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF ROTTERDAM, ELIMINATING ONE-WAY TRAFFIC FLOW ON LAURA STREET BETWEEN GUILDERLAND AVENUE AND PAULINE AVENUE

**THEREFORE, UPON MOTION OF Councilmember DODSON, seconded by Councilmember MASTROIANNI,
BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN BOARD AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1. The Town Board hereby enacts Introductory Local Law No. 4 of 2024.

SECTION 2. The Town Clerk is directed, following consultation with the Attorney to the Town, to file said Local Law in final form with the New York State Department of State.

SECTION 3. This resolution shall become effective March 27, 2024.
