RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE DATE FOR THE FILING OF NOMINATING PETITIONS THAT IS ESABLISHED BY STATE LAW

WHEREAS, at present, Section 4.10(B) of the Rockwood City Charter provides that nominating petitions for City positions must be filed before 4:00 p.m. on the seventh Tuesday prior to the primary election; and

WHEREAS, in 2012 the Michigan legislature adopted a statute, MCL 168.644f(1), which requires that the deadline for filing nominating petitions is before 4:00 pm on the fifteenth Tuesday prior to the odd year primary election; and

WHEREAS, Under the Home Rule Cities Act, MCL 117.3(b)(3), regardless of any Charter provision to the contrary, the City may approve by resolution any election provision which is consistent with Michigan law;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

1. The City Council hereby approves the state law requirement that nominating petitions for City elected offices must be filed by 4:00 p.m. on the fifteenth Tuesday prior to the odd year primary election; and

2. The City Clerk is directed to contact the Codifier and direct that an annotation be included at the end of Rockwood Charter Section 4.10(B) which provides:

"[NOTE: The charter language pertaining to filing nominating petitions for city elections is superceded by Michigan election law, MCL 168.644f(1). The candidate nomination petition filing deadline is 4:00 p.m. on the fifteenth (15th) Tuesday prior to the odd year primary election."
