#### SECTION 1. PURPOSE AND INTENT

This local law shall be known as "A Local Law Establishing Income Levels for Real Property Tax Exemptions for Senior Citizens." The purpose of this local law is to recognize and update the real property tax exemptions for senior citizens authorized under New York Real Property Tax Law and contained in the Town Code of the Town of Sand Lake.

#### **SECTION 2. AUTHORIZATION**

This local law is enacted pursuant to the requirements set forth in the New York State Real Property Tax Law §467 to establish income levels for real property tax exemptions for senior citizens.

#### SECTION 3. ENACTMENT

The Town of Sand Lake hereby adopts the following sliding scale schedule relative to the income levels and the percentage of assessed valuation exempt from taxation:

#### SEE ATTACHED SCHEDULE

Eligibility shall be determined in accordance with New York Real Property Tax Law §467.

#### SECTION 4. REPEALER

Any prior local law currently in existence that is inconsistent with the terms of this local law is hereby repealed.

#### SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the Office of the New York State Secretary of State.

- (C) The aggregated amount of all losses shall not exceed fifteen thousand dollars.
