

RESOLUTION NO. 10-2023-1793

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SALISBURY, LEHIGH COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA SUPPORTING AN ACT 537 SEWAGE FACILITIES PLAN UPDATE PUBLIC-TO-PUBLIC WASTEWATER DISPOSAL SYSTEM TRANSFER FOR SOUTH WHITEHALL TOWNSHIP, LEHIGH COUNTY

WHEREAS, Section 5 of the Act of January 24, 1966, P.L. 1535, No. 537 known as the “Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act”, as amended, and the Rules and Regulations of the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (“the Department”) adopted thereunder, Chapter 71 of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania Code, required municipalities to adopt an Official Sewage Facilities Plan providing for sewage facilities adequate to prevent contamination of waters and/or environmental health hazards with sewage wastes, and to revise said plan whenever it is necessary to meet the sewage disposal needs of the municipality; and

WHEREAS, Spotts, Stevens and McCoy has prepared an Act 537 Sewage Facilities Plan Update Public-to-Public Wastewater Disposal System Transfer (“Plan Update”) for South Whitehall Township (“municipality”); and

WHEREAS, South Whitehall Township confirms the dissolution of the South Whitehall Township Authority; and


WHEREAS, South Whitehall Township Authority intends to convey all property, maintenance, and asset management responsibilities to South Whitehall Township; and

WHEREAS, Salisbury Township, Lehigh County conveys a portion of its wastewater through South Whitehall Township’s (“municipality”) sewer system.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Salisbury Township, Lehigh County has found no issues of concern regarding South Whitehall Township’s Act 537 Sewage Facilities Plan Update and is found to be adequate for the wastewater disposal and management needs of the municipality and hereby adopts the Plan Update known as the South Whitehall Township Act 537 Sewage Facilities Plan Update Public-to-Public Wastewater Disposal System Transfer, dated August 2023, as a revision to the Official Plan of the municipality.
