WHEREAS there has been presented to the Town Board of the Town of Southold, Suffolk County, New York, on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of April, 2024, a Local Law entitled "A Local Law in relation to an Amendment to Chapter 189, Parking," and

**WHEREAS** the Town Board of the Town of Southold held a public hearing on the aforesaid Local Law at which time all interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard, now therefor be it

RESOLVED that the Town Board of the Town of Southold hereby ENACTS the proposed Local Law entitled, "A Local Law in relation to an Amendment to Chapter 189, Parking," which reads as follows:

LOCAL LAW NO. 8 2024

A Local Law entitled, "A Local Law in relation to an Amendment to Chapter 189, Parking,"

BE IT ENACTED by the Town Board of the Town of Southold as follows:

## I. Purpose

The Purpose of the amendment is to improve safety for emergency vehicles, pedestrian and passenger vehicles, as well as dealing with impacts to the public's health, safety and welfare resulting from vehicles.

#### II. Amendment.

The Southold Town Code is hereby amended by removing the struck through words and adding the underlined words as follows:

## § 189-2 Designation of parking areas requiring permits.

- B. The following road end areas are hereby designated as Town of Southold "Parking by Southold Town Permit Only" areas:
- (62) King Street, also known as "Hog Pond Road," Orient Harbor, Orient, along both sides from the terminus north for a distance of 300 feet to Harbor Road.
- (63) Bay Avenue, Gardiners Bay, East Marion, along both sides from the terminus north to the bridge.
- (64) Pipe's Neck Road, Greenport, along both sides from the footbridge north 300 feet.

- C. The following boat ramp areas are hereby designated as Town of Southold "Parking by Southold Town Permit Only" areas:
- (1) King Street, also known as "Hog Pond Road," Orient Harbor, Orient, along both sides from the terminus north for a distance of 300 feet to Harbor Road.
- (2)(1) Narrow River Road, Hallock's Bay, Orient, parking area on south side known and referred to herein as "Narrow River Road Launching Ramp" and along both sides of Narrow River Road for a distance of 350 feet north and 350 feet south of the entrance for the parking area.
- (3) Bay Avenue, Gardiners Bay, East Marion, along both sides from the terminus north to the bridge.
- (4) Pipe's Neck Road, Greenport, along both sides from the terminus north 300 feet.
- (5)(2) Bayview Avenue South, Hashamomuck Pond, Southold, along both sides from the terminus east for a distance of 140 feet.
- (6)(3) Gagen's Landing Road, Goose Creek, Southold, along both sides from the terminus north to Clearview Avenue.
- (7)(4) Lake Court, Great Pond, also known as "Leetons Lake," Southold, along both sides from the terminus north to Lake Drive.
- (8)(4) Minnehaha Boulevard, also known as "Nokomis Road," Corey Creek, Southold, parking area adjacent to launching area.
- (9)(6) Pine Neck Road, Jockey Creek, Southold, along both sides from the terminus west to North Bayview Avenue.
- (10)(7) Parkers Landing Road, Richmond Creek, Peconic, from the terminus west to Indian Neck Lane.
- (11)(8) Little Neck Road, East Creek, Cutchogue, along both sides from the terminus north for a distance of 250 feet.
- (12)(9) Wilson Landing, East Creek, also known as "Eugene's Creek," Cutchogue, along both sides from the terminus east to Beebe Drive.
- (13)(10) County Road 48, Mattituck Creek, Mattituck, parking area on north side known and referred to herein as "Town Launching Ramp at Mattituck Creek."
