ORDINANCE NO. 2024- 01

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PART II, CHAPTER 331 OF
THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF SPRING GROVE
BOROUGH, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,
ENTITLED “SOLID WASTE”, TO SPECIFY THE PROPER
DISPOSAL OF CONSTRUCTION, RENOVATION, AND
DEMOLITION WASTE WITHIN THE BOROUGH LIMITS**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Spring Grove (the “Borough”) desires to modify portions of its Refuse Ordinance pertaining to the proper disposal of waste generated from the construction, renovation, or demolition of buildings or other structures (“Construction Waste”); and

WHEREAS, the Borough believes it is in the best interest of the Borough residents, and the Borough-contracted refuse hauler, to limit the disposal of Construction waste within the Borough.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Spring Grove, York County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the municipality of the same, as follows, to wit:

Section 1. Section 331-2 of the Borough of Spring Grove Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended by amending the definitions of “Refuse” and “Rubbish” therein as follows:

REFUSE – All solid wastes, except human body wastes and construction waste, including, without limitation, garbage, ashes, and rubbish. It shall also include bagged animal excreta and diapered human child excreta.

RUBBISH – Includes glass, metal, paper, plant growth, wood, and nonputrescible solid wastes, excluding construction waste.

Section 2. Section 331-2 of the Borough of Spring Grove Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended by adding the definition of “Construction Waste” therein as follows:

CONSTRUCTION WASTE – Solid waste resulting from the construction, renovation, or demolition of buildings and other structures, including, but not limited to, wood, plaster, metals, asphaltic substances, bricks, block, and unsegregated concrete, but specifically excluding waste from land clearing, grubbing, and excavation, including trees, brush, stumps, and vegetative material.

Section 3. Section 331-9 of the Borough of Spring Grove Zoning Ordinance entitled “Disposal of refuse” is hereby amended by deleting the contents thereof and adding the following in its place:

No person shall hereafter dispose of any refuse collected in the Borough of Spring Grove, York County, Pennsylvania, except by conveyance to a disposal facility approved by the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection. Construction waste shall be disposed of in accordance with Chapter 335, Storage Containers and Dumpsters, and not with garbage, rubbish, and refuse disposed of in accordance with this Chapter 331, except for one (1) item of construction waste to be collected on the Borough-designated collection day for bulky rubbish within the Borough.


Section 4. This amendment shall be effective immediately upon enactment.


