

ORDINANCE NO. 2020-06

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SWATARA, CHAPTER 271, THEREOF ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC," TO ESTABLISH SPECIAL PURPOSE PARKING ZONES, TO ELIMINATE SPECIAL PARKING ZONES, AND TO PROHIBIT PARKING ON CERTAIN STREETS

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Swatara, County of Dauphin, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 271, Article IV, §271-35, "Special Purpose Parking Zones Established; Parking Otherwise Prohibited," is hereby amended by the inclusion under the name of highway, Side of Street, Authorized Purpose of Vehicle and Location, the following:

HIGHWAY	SIDE	AUTHORIZED PURPOSE OF VEHICLE (Handicapped Parking)	LOCATION
618 Main Street	South	Anthony Radic	Beginning at a point 48 feet west of the Southwest corner of the intersection of Main Street and Center Street, extending 20 feet west in front of 618 Main Street.
4701 Lancaster Street East		Joe and Joan Danish	Beginning at a point 50 feet and 6 inches south of the curb line of the southeast corner of Lancaster Street at North 47 th Street, extending south 25 feet
581 North Street	East	Donna Schmigiel	Beginning at a point 46 feet west of the Northwest corner of the intersection of North Street and Center Street with the Sign facing east, extending 20 feet east From the sign, ending at the existing no Parking here to corner sign

SECTION 2. Chapter 271, Article IV, §271-35, "Special Purpose Parking Zones Established; Parking Otherwise Prohibited," is hereby amended by the elimination under the name of Highway, Side of Street, Authorized Purpose of Vehicle and Location, the following:

HIGHWAY	SIDE	AUTHORIZED PURPOSE OF VEHICLE (Handicapped Parking)	LOCATION
447 Highland Street	North	Richard L. Trace	Beginning at a point, said point located on the northern line of Highland Street, said point also being located a distance of 176 feet, more or less, southwest of the northwestern intersection of Boyer

Street and Highland Street, thence continuing along the northern line of Highland Street in a southwestern direction a distance of 25 feet, being the entire frontage of 447 Highland Street.

425 2 nd Street	Northeast	Linda K. Warren	Beginning at a point, said point being Located on the northeastern side of 2 nd Street, said point also being located a distance of 59 feet southwest of the northwest corner of the intersection of 2 nd Street and Williams Street; thence continuing in a southwest direction a distance of 20 feet; being the frontage of 425 2 nd Street
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SECTION 3. Chapter 271, Article IV, "General Parking Regulations," §271-31, "Parking prohibited at all times in certain locations," is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following:

HIGHWAY	SIDE	BETWEEN
North 69 th Street	West	Beginning at the southwest corner of the intersection of North 69 th Street and Somerset Street, and extending 47 feet to the south on the west side of North 69 th Street
69 th Street	Southeast	Beginning at the southeast corner of the intersection of Clearfield Street, extending 75 feet to the south
69 th Street	Northeast	Beginning at the northeast corner of the intersection of Clearfield Street, extending 90 feet to the north
69 th Street	Southeast	Beginning at the southeast corner of the intersection of Huntingdon Street, extending 76 feet to the south
69 th Street	Northeast	Beginning at the northeast corner of the intersection of Huntingdon Street, extending 106 feet to the north
69 th Street	Southeast	Beginning at the southeast corner of the intersection of Somerset Street, extending 82 feet to the south
69 th Street	Northeast	Beginning at the northeast corner of the intersection of Somerset Street, extending 92 feet to the north

SECTION 4. Severability. If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Board of Commissioners that

this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid sentence, clause, section, or part thereof not been included herein.

SECTION 5. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.


SECTION 6. Effective Date. The effective date of this Ordinance shall be its date of enactment.
