

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-04

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SWATARA, CHAPTER 271, THEREOF ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC," TO ESTABLISH SPECIAL PURPOSE PARKING ZONES, TO ELIMINATE SPECIAL PARKING ZONES, AND TO PROHIBIT PARKING ON CERTAIN STREETS

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Swatara, County of Dauphin, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 271, Article IV, §271-35, "Special Purpose Parking Zones Established; Parking Otherwise Prohibited," is hereby amended by the inclusion under the name of highway, Side of Street, Authorized Purpose of Vehicle and Location, the following:

1001 Monroe Street	North	William Sersch	Beginning at a point 69 feet west of the northwest corner of the intersection of Monroe and Beale Streets, 20 feet in length, in front of 1001 Monroe Street
2 <sup>nd</sup> Street	North	Cheryl White	Beginning at a point 90 feet west of the southwest corner of 2 <sup>nd</sup> Street and Center Street, and extending 20 feet west from that point along the southern side of 570 2 <sup>nd</sup> Street
300 N. 69 <sup>th</sup> Street	South	Josefina Diaz	Beginning at a point 54 feet west of the northwest corner of North 69 <sup>th</sup> Street and Somerset Street and extending 20 feet west from that point along the northern side of Somerset Street.
576 2 <sup>nd</sup> Street	South	Mildred Hilton Cynthia Russell	The first space beginning at a point 42 feet west of the south-west corner of the intersection of 2 <sup>nd</sup> Street and Center Street extending 15 feet; the second space immediately adjacent, beginning 57 feet west of the south-west corner of the same intersection extending 15 feet along the southern side of 576 2 <sup>nd</sup> Street

1249 Main Street	West	David Lebo	Beginning at a point 83 feet south of the southwest corner of Main Street and Pleasant Avenue, extending 25 feet north from that point along the western side of Main Street, the front of 1249 Main Street
North 48 <sup>th</sup> Street	West	Christopher Reed	Beginning at a point 96 feet south of the curb line extension of the southwest corner of Stricker Street at North 48th Street. It would then extend along the curb line to the south for a distance of 25 feet, directly adjacent to the walkway.
665 Highland Street	North	Mohamed Smallwood	Beginning at a point 154 feet east of the curb line extension of the northeast corner of Hoover Street at Highland Street. It would then extend along the curb line to the east for a distance of 25 feet, directly adjacent to the walkway, fronting 665 Highland Street
1020 Orange Street	North	Janet Schaffhauser	Beginning at a point 238 feet west of the northwest corner of the intersection of North Harrisburg Street and Orange Street, extending 20 feet east, fronting 1020 Orange Street
1020 Orange Street	North	Walter Schaffhauser	Beginning at a point 218 feet west of the northwest corner of the intersection of North Harrisburg Street and Orange Street, extending 20 feet east, fronting 1020 Orange Street.

SECTION 2. Chapter 271, Article IV, §271-35, "Special Purpose Parking Zones Established; Parking Otherwise Prohibited," is hereby amended by the elimination under the name of Highway, Side of Street, Authorized Purpose of Vehicle and Location, the following:

482 and 484 Kelker	Northeast	Melvin and Bonnie Pike	Beginning at a point, said point being located on the northeastern line of Kelker Street, said point also being located 295 feet northwest of the northeastern intersection of Kelker Street and Memory Lane, also being located at the northern curbline of the driveway of 482 Kelker Street, thence continuing along the eastern line of Kelker Street in a northwesterly direction a distance of 14 feet; being a portion of the properties located at 482 and 484 Kelker Street.
565 3 <sup>rd</sup> Street	Northwest	Mary Deckman	Beginning at a point located on the northwestern line of 3rd Street, said point also being located a distance of 120 feet; more or less, southwest of the northwestern corner of the intersection of Center Street and 3rd Street, thence continuing along the northwestern line of 3rd Street in a southwesterly direction a distance of 24 feet, more or less; being the frontage of 565 3rd Street
Somerset Street	South	Francisco Diaz	Beginning at a point located 54 feet west of the northwest corner of 69th Street and Somerset Street, and extending 20 feet west from that point along the northern curb
Monroe Street	South	Yvonne Hilmer	Beginning at a point on the south side of Monroe Street, said point also being located 28 feet to the west of the southwest corner of the intersection of Monroe Street and Cherry Alley, and extending 20 feet west from that point along the frontage of 602 Monroe Street.
4115 York Street	South	Carmela Schatt	Beginning at a point, said point being located on the southern line of York Street, said point also being located a distance of

110 feet west of the southwest corner of the intersection of 42nd Street and York Street, thence continuing along the southern line of York Street in a westerly direction for a distance of 26 feet; being the entire frontage of the property of 4115 York Street

6735 Somerset Street South

Sharon St. Clair

Beginning at a point 200 feet east of the southeast corner of the intersection of 67th Street and Somerset Street (Veteran's Circle), on the south side of Somerset Street, 20 feet in length, proceeding to the east, being the frontage of 6735 Somerset Street

SECTION 3. Chapter 271, Article IV, "General Parking Regulations," §271-31, "Parking prohibited at all times in certain locations," is hereby amended by the eliminating the following:

HIGHWAY	SIDE	BETWEEN
46 <sup>th</sup> Street	South	Beginning at a point, said point being located 44 feet, 3 inches from the northern curbline extension of York Street and extend to the north for a distance of 48 feet, 1 inch (to the southern edge of the former Lawnton Fire Company driveway)

SECTION 4. Chapter 271, Article IV, "General Parking Regulations," §271-31, "Parking prohibited at all times in certain locations," is hereby amended by the inclusion under the name of highway, Side of Street, Authorized Purpose of Vehicle and Location, the following:

Kelker Street	North	Beginning at the north side of Cole Alley and extending to the north for a distance of 368 feet

SECTION 5. Chapter 271, Article VII, "Pedestrian Regulations," §271-54, "Pedestrian-control signal locations established," is hereby amended by the inclusion under the name of highway, and location, the following:

HIGHWAY	BETWEEN
High Pointe Boulevard	An 8-foot-wide crosswalk shall be installed extending across High Pointe Boulevard on the northern corners of the intersecting driveways attached to the properties at 4251 Chambers Hill Road and 4391 Chambers Hill Road. A "Zebra Style" stripe pattern should be utilized and proper signage installed at the crosswalk and well in advance of the crosswalk to warn motorists of its presence.

501 Mall Road

A 12 foot wide crosswalk shall be installed extending across Mall Road at 501 Mall Road. Beginning approximately 526 feet from the northwest corner of the intersection at Mall Road and North Harrisburg Street as measured along the western curb. A "Ladder Style" stripe pattern should be utilized and proper signage installed at the crosswalk and well in advance of the crosswalk to warn motorists of its presence.

SECTION 6. Severability. If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Board of Commissioners that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid sentence, clause, section, or part thereof not been included herein.

SECTION 7. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.


SECTION 8. Effective Date. The effective date of this Ordinance shall be its date of enactment.
