

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-08

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SWATARA, CHAPTER 271, THEREOF ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC," TO ESTABLISH SPECIAL PURPOSE PARKING ZONES, TO ELIMINATE SPECIAL PARKING ZONES, AND TO PROHIBIT PARKING ON CERTAIN STREETS

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Swatara, County of Dauphin, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 271, Article IV, §271-35, "Special Purpose Parking Zones Established; Parking Otherwise Prohibited," is hereby amended by the inclusion under the name of Highway, Side of Street, Authorized Purpose of Vehicle and Location, the following:

471 2nd Street	North	Dawn Raab	Beginning at a point 74 feet west of the northwest corner of 2 nd Street and Boyer Street, extending 20 feet east from that point along the northern side of 2nd Street, along the frontage of 471 2 nd Street
Rutherford Street	South	Charles Beachler	Beginning at a point 180 feet west of the southwest corner of Rutherford Street and Francis L. Cadden Parkway, extending 20 feet west from that point along the southern side of Rutherford Street.
Somerset Street	Northwest	Michael Stilley Holly Stilley	Beginning at a point at the front concrete walkway associated with 8060 Somerset Street, Apartment 1, approximately 1,139 feet from the curb line extension of the northwest corner of the intersection between Somerset Street and Nyes Road. The parking area would extend 20 feet to the west of this point, in front of 8060 Somerset Street, Apartment 1
Mohn Street	South	Dorothy Middleton	Beginning at a point 692 feet to the west of the curb line extension, taken from the northwest corner of

			the intersection of Mohn Street and 6 th Street, 20 feet long proceeding to the west, and ending 7 feet from the crosswalk that connects 400 Mohn Street to 301 Mohn Street. In front of 400 Mohn Street, Units 11-12.
York Street	South	Ronald Stimeling	Beginning at a point 179 feet west of the southwest corner of the intersection of South 42nd Street and York Street, extending 20 feet along the frontage of 4111 York Street
Highland Street	South	Sarah Filizzi	Beginning at a point 553 feet east of the northeast corner of Highland Street and Hager Avenue, south extending 20 feet west from that point between the driveways of 864 and 878 Highland Street
6721 Clearfield	South	Frances Gilchrist	Beginning at a point 107.4 feet west of the southwest corner of 68th Street and Clearfield Street, extending 20 feet west from that point along the southern side of Clearfield Street
301 Mohn Street	South	JoAnn Lanier	Beginning at a point 822 feet 6 inches to the west of the curb line extension, taken from the northwest corner of the intersection of Mohn Street and 6th Street, 20 feet long proceeding to the west, across the street from 301 Mohn Street
20 Delmont Ave.	Northwest	Charles Webster	Beginning at a point 240 feet north of the curb line extension, at the northwest corner of the westerly intersection of Delmont Avenue and Lancaster Street, 20 feet in length, along the front of 20 Delmont Avenue

SECTION 2. Chapter 271, Article IV, §271-35, "Special Purpose Parking Zones Established; Parking Otherwise Prohibited," is hereby amended by the elimination under the name of Highway, Side of Street, Authorized Purpose of Vehicle and Location, the following:

4921 Lancaster	South	Pearl Platt	Beginning at a point, said point being located 195 feet west of the southwest corner of the intersection of Lancaster Street and 50th Street; thence continuing along the southern line of Lancaster Street, in a westerly direction, a distance of 20 feet; being a portion of the frontage of 4921 Lancaster Street
559 Main Street	North	Wayne A. Smith	Beginning at a point located 68 feet west of the northwest corner of Main Street and Essex Street, and extending 20 feet east from that point along the frontage of 559 Main Street
3701 Brisban St	South	W. Allan Romberger	Beginning at a point, said point being located on the southern line of Brisban Street, said point also being located a distance of 80 feet east of the southeast corner of the intersection of Brisban Street and Wilhelm Road, thence continuing along the southern line of Brisban Street in a westerly direction for a distance of 20 feet; being the frontage of 3701 Brisban Street

SECTION 3. Chapter 271, Article IV, "General Parking Regulations," §271-31, "Parking Prohibited at all Times in Certain Locations," is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following:

HIGHWAY	SIDE	BETWEEN
Chambers Street	North	Beginning at the north side of Chambers Street from Center Street to Plum Alley
Chambers Street	South	Beginning at the south side of Chambers Street from Center Street to a point 56.5 feet east
Mohn Street	South	Beginning at a point 421 feet west of the curb line Extension taken from the northwest corner of the intersection of Mohn Street and 6th Street, then extending 112 feet to the east
Mohn Street	South	Beginning at a point 822 feet 6 inches from the curb line extension of the northwest corner at Mohn Street and 6th Street and extending 48 feet 6 inches to the east, ending at the driveway entrance to 400 Mohn Street, units 11-12

SECTION 4. Severability. If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Board of Commissioners that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid sentence, clause, section, or part thereof not been included herein.

SECTION 5. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.


SECTION 6. Effective Date. The effective date of this Ordinance shall be its date of enactment.
