ORDINANCE No. 24-02

ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF CALVIN STREET IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, NEW JERSEY, AND APPROPRIATING \$166,168 THEREFOR CONSTITUTING PROCEEDS OF A GRANT FROM THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, NEW JERSEY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The improvement or purpose described in Section 2 of this ordinance is hereby authorized a general improvement to be made or acquired by The Township of Washington, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey, and there is hereby appropriated therefor the sum of \$166,168 constituting moneys received or expected to be received by the Township from the New Jersey Department of Transportation, as a grant-in-aid of financing said improvement. The total cost of said improvement or purpose is estimated to be \$300,000 and the balance of the cost (i.e., \$133,832) will be met by the Township from monies in Capital Fund Balance of the Township.

Section 2: The improvement hereby authorized and the purpose for the financing of which the appropriation is made as provided in Section 1 of this ordinance is the improvement of Calvin Street in and by the Township by the construction or reconstruction therein of a new roadway pavement, including all lighting, pathways, sidewalks, curbing, crosswalks and signage, milling, landscaping, curbing, drainage facilities, equipment, site work, work and materials necessary therefor or incidental thereto, all as shown on and in


accordance with the plans and specifications therefor on file or to be filed in the office of the Township Clerk and hereby approved.

Section 3: The capital budget or temporary capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing all detail of the amended capital budget or temporary capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, are on file with the Township Clerk and are available for public inspection.

Section 4: This ordinance shall take effect after publication after final passage as provided by law


