Article

PURPOSE

The Town of Wawayanda, pursuant to the authority granted by Agriculture and Markets Law, section 305 (6) as amended by Chapter 562 of the Laws of 1991, hereby intends to extend the application of the agricultural exemption provided in the Agriculture and Markets Law, Section 305 (1) to include the fire and ambulance districts within the Town of Wawayanda as follows:

SECTION 1

It is hereby enacted that, in accordance with New York Agriculture and Markets Law, Section 305 (6), the assessment determined pursuant to Subdivision one of said Section 305 for property in the Town of Wawayanda shall also be used for the benefit assessment of special assessment levy for fire or ambulance districts,

SECTION 2

This Local Law shall take place immediately and shall apply to assessment rolls prepared on the basis of taxable status dates occurring on or after January 1, 1992.
