ORDINANCE NO. 2021-019**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 268 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF WALLINGTON ENTITLED "PEACE AND GOOD ORDER"

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF WALLINGTON AS FOLLOWS:

1. Chapter 268 of the Code of the Borough of Wallington, Peace and Good Order be and is hereby amended and supplemented to add a new Article III to be read as follows:

ARTICLE III PROHIBITION OF CANNABIS BUSINESSES

§268-11 All **Classes of Cannabis Prohibited.** Pursuant to Section 31b of the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory, Enforcement Assistance, and Marketplace Modernization Act (P.L. 2021, c. 16), all cannabis establishments, cannabis distributors or cannabis delivery services are hereby prohibited from operating anywhere in the Borough of Wallington, except for the delivery of cannabis items and related supplies by a delivery service.

§268-12 Penalties. Any person found guilty of violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to such fines and penalties as set forth in Section 1-15 of the Borough Code.

2. All ordinances or parts which are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, but only to the extent of such inconsistency.
3. This ordinance shall take effect after publication thereof and final passage as required by law.
