ORDINANCE NO. 2021-022**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT CHAPTER 325 OF THE CODE OF
THE BOROUGH OF WALLINGTON TO CLARIFY RESPONSIBILITIES AND
SPECIFICATIONS FOR SIDEWALK MAINTENANCE**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF WALLINGTON AS
FOLLOWS:**

1. Subsection D of Section 325-22 of the Borough Code is amended and supplemented to read as follows:

D. Specifications.

(1) All materials and work shall be in accordance with the following specifications and such other specifications as may be required by the Borough Engineer:

(a) All sidewalks shall be at least 4-inch-thick Portland cement concrete with a $\frac{3}{4}$ inch, 4-inch-thick clear stone sub-base, compacted sub-grade;

(b) All sidewalks shall have a minimum width of 4 feet;

(c) All sidewalks in vehicular areas adjacent to and including driveway apron shall be 6 inch thick re-enforced Portland cement concrete with a minimum 4 inch thick dense graded aggregate and compacted sub-grade;

(d) All concrete and sub-grade material shall be in accordance with sidewalks and driveways' specifications under current and New Jersey Department of Transportation standard specifications;

(e) All soil, stone or other fill materials either imported onto or exported from the property shall comply with all applicable federal, state, county and local regulations and requirements;

(f) All concrete sidewalks shall have saw-cut joints, 1/2-inch-deep, every 5 feet.

2. Chapter 325 of the Code of the Borough of Wallington is amended supplemented by adding thereto a new Article V entitled "Sidewalk Maintenance" to read as follows:

Article V Sidewalk Maintenance.

Section 325-26 Responsibility to Repair or Replace Sidewalks. All sidewalks adjoining streets, roads and highways within the Borough of Wallington shall be kept in good repair. The owners, tenants and occupants of improved or unimproved premises abutting upon public sidewalks within the Borough shall repair and/or replace a sidewalk abutting the property which shall become damaged, broken, uneven, or in any manner disruptive so as to create a hazard to pedestrian traffic.

Section 325-27 Materials and Matter of Construction. All sidewalk repairs shall be completed in accordance with this Article (or including but not limited to Section 325-22 of this Code or as otherwise directed by the Borough Engineer.

3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed, but only to the extent of such inconsistency.

4. This ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication as prescribed by law.
