

ORDINANCE NO. 1181

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF WAYNESBORO, FRANKLIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA REPEALING IN ITS ENTIRETY ARTICLE I, OF CHAPTER 265 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF WAYNESBORO TO ELIMINATE THE AMUSEMENT DEVICE TAX

WHEREAS, Borough Council of the Borough of Waynesboro, Franklin County, Pennsylvania deems it to be in the best interest and the general welfare of the citizens and residents of the Borough to repeal Article I of Chapter 265 of the Code of the Borough of Waynesboro which imposed a license tax on certain amusement uses and devices within the Borough of Waynesboro.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Waynesboro, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

SECTION 1: Chapter 265, Article I, of the Code of the Borough of Waynesboro, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, entitled "Amusement Devices" is hereby repealed in its entirety and amended to read as follows: (Reserved).

SECTION 2: Repealer. All provisions of previous ordinances of the Code, which are contrary to this Ordinance, are expressly repealed.

SECTION 3: Severability. If any word, phrase, sentence, part, section, subsection, or other portion of this ordinance or any application thereof to any person or circumstance is declared void, unconstitutional, or invalid for any reason, then such word, phrase, sentence, part, section, subsection, or other portion, or the proscribed application thereof, shall be severable and the remaining provisions of this ordinance and all applications thereof, not having been declared void, unconstitutional, or invalid, shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
