

ORDINANCE NO. 1194

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF WAYNESBORO, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, fixing the tax rate for the fiscal year 2022.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Waynesboro, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania:

Section 1. That the tax rate be and the same is hereby levied on all real property within the said Borough subject to taxation for Borough purposes for the fiscal year 2022 as follows:

Tax rate for general Borough purposes, the sum of twenty-two and eighteen hundredths (22.18) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation.

Tax rate for fire purposes, as authorized by 8 Pa. C.S.A. §1302(a)(6), the sum of three (3.0) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation. Said revenues will be deposited into the general fund and expended for the purposes of fire suppression personnel salaries (up to 1.0 mill), repair and maintenance of apparatus, fire hose and fire house.

Tax rate for rescue service purposes, as authorized by 8 Pa. C.S.A. §1302(a)(9), the sum of one-half (0.50) mill on each dollar of assessed valuation. Said revenues will be deposited into the general fund and expended for the purpose of supporting ambulance, rescue and other emergency services serving the Borough.

Tax rate for street lights, the sum of three (3.0) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation. Said revenues of the street light tax will be deposited in a separate Street Light Fund and expended from same for the purpose of street light expenses within the Borough of Waynesboro.

Tax rate for street improvements, the sum of zero (0) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation. Said revenues of the street improvement tax will be deposited in a separate Street Improvement Fund and expended from same for street improvements within the Borough of Waynesboro or debt retirements associated thereto.

Tax rate for dedicated debt service purposes, as authorized by 8 Pa. C.S.A. §1302(a)(1), the sum of six and seventy-five hundredths (6.75) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation. Said revenues will be deposited into the general and street funds, and expended for the purpose of emergency services communication equipment and PENNVEST stormwater debt.

Section 2. That any Ordinance, or part of Ordinance, conflicting with this Ordinance, be and the same is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this Ordinance.
