

**ORDINANCE 21-16**  
**TOWNSHIP COUNCIL - TOWNSHIP OF MINE HILL**  
**MORRIS COUNTY, NEW JERSEY**  
**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MINE HILL AND ESTABLISHING A REQUIREMENT FOR THE POSTING OF A SECURITY DEPOSIT FOR THOSE USING THE CIVIC CENTER**

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Council of the Township of Mine Hill, in the County of Morris, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 235 of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Mine Hill, "Fees", shall be amended by the following amendment to Subsection L of Section 235-29 which shall read, in its entirety, as follows:

L. Civic Center Fees.

- (1) Use of Civic Center. Organizations desiring to utilize the Civic Center for meetings, recreation, or other purposes may be granted permission to utilize the Civic Center under conditions set forth in the Township of Mine Hill's "Policy for Use of Township Facilities."
- (2) Fee for use of Civic Center. Organizations using the Civic Center shall pay a fee as follows:
  - (a) Rates per day:
    - [1] Day use rate: \$100.
    - [2] Evening rate: \$50.
  - (b) A not-for-profit organization which does not charge fees for the activity taking place at the Civic Center shall be exempt from the fee. A not-for-profit organization which charges fees for the activity taking place at the Civic Center shall pay a reduced fee of \$40 for day use and \$25 for evening use.
  - (c) Security Deposit. In addition to the fees set forth in this subsection, a security deposit in the amount of \$100.00 for residents of Mine Hill and \$200.00 for all others may be required by users who have not established a history of leaving the facility in a clean condition after use. The deposit will be used to cover the Township's cost in having the facility cleaned in the event the user has damaged or has not adequately cleaned up the facility after use. It deposit will be returned if the facility is left in an appropriate condition.

Section 2. All Ordinances of the Township of Mine Hill which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final publication and in accordance with law.
