ORDINANCE NO. 23-002

AN ORDINANCE OF AKRON BOROUGH ACCEPTING DEDICATION OF A
PORTION OF WEST VIEW DRIVE AND ADDITIONAL RIGHT-OF-WAY
ALONG WEST VIEW DRIVE AS PART OF THE PUBLIC ROAD SYSTEM
IN AKRON BOROUGH

WHEREAS, in accordance with plans and various approvals granted by Borough Council, roadway improvements in accordance with those plans have been undertaken on a certain street within the Borough, known as West View Drive.

WHEREAS, an offer for dedication of West View Drive and additional right-of-way along West View Drive has been made to the Borough.

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the Borough to accept dedication of West View Drive and additional right-of-way, together with all improvements, to add to the public road system within the Borough.


NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by Akron Borough, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania as follows:

1. Borough Council hereby authorizes acceptance of dedication of West View Drive, including all improvements, together with additional right-of-way.
2. West View Drive, as described in Exhibit A which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference, shall be and hereby becomes part of the public road system of Akron Borough. A plan depicting West View Drive is attached as Exhibit B and made a part hereof.
3. The officials of the Borough are hereby authorized to do and perform all acts necessary and required under the Borough Code and the Act of Assembly Allocating Fuel Taxes to Municipalities (72 P.S. §2615.1 et seq.) to accept such streets as part of the public road system of the Akron Borough.
4. In the event any provision, section, sentence, clause, or part of this Resolution shall be held to be invalid, illegal, or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity, illegality, or unconstitutional shall not affect or impair the remaining provisions, sections, sentences, clauses, or parts of this Resolution, it being the intent of the Supervisors that the remainder of the Resolution shall be and shall remain in full force and effect.
5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon adoption.




