LOCAL LAW NO. 5 OF 2019 REPEAL and REPLACEMENT of Village of Alexandria Bay – Docks, Public Local Law No. 3 of 2019

The existing Local Law shall be amended by the addition of the following; the repeal of the identified provision and/or replacement as follows:

§60-5. Commercial water related enterprises repealed in its entirety, and the following language shall be inserted instead and in place thereof:

Commercial water-related enterprises, which include, fishing guides, marina operators, excursion and tour boats BASED IN the Village of Alexandria Bay, may dock at any public dock, except the Scenic View Park Dock, for the purpose of boarding and discharging passengers between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. and between the hours of 4:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. for a period not to exceed one (1) hour with the exception of fishing guides belonging to the Alex Bay Fishing Guides Association whose permitted hours will be from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.

Commercial water-related enterprises, which include fishing guides, marina operators, excursion and tour boats BASED OUTSIDE the Village of Alexandria Bay, may dock at any public dock, except the Scenic View Park Dock, for the purpose of DISCHARGING and REBOARDING those same passengers between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. for a period not to exceed one (1) hour.

A 30-foot yellow line will be marked on the area of the Upper James Street docks which will be used only by fishing guides belonging to the Alex Bay Fishing Guide Association for the purpose of picking up and discharging passengers. The "yellow line" may be "moved" at times, depending on the depth of the water at certain times of the year.
